# **CELEBRATING PEOPLE MADE IN GOD'S IMAGE**

In session one, we learned that being made in the Image of God is directly related to our sexuality. We learned that God wanted to fill His entire creation with humans, made in His image, reflecting His faithful, loving, creative care of the Earth. The truth that every person bears the Image of their Creator should radically transform how we understand ourselves, our children, and every person.

Being made in God's Image is the foundation for our children's self-regard and self-confidence. They are a one-of-a-kind replica of their Maker, handmade by God (Psalm 139). He has given them talents, abilities, perspectives, and experiences that don't belong to anyone else. This is also the foundation for their humility; they have been made for God's glory, not their own.

And just as any attack on an earthly king's image would be considered an attack on the king himself, God regards any attack on a human being as a rejection of His authority. For our children, this means God cares about everything that happens to them. God also cares how our children treat others. Let's teach them to treat others the way God wants them to be treated.

Below are some examples that teens have shared of practical ways their parents show affirmation, affection, and achievement.

#### **AFFIRMATION**

To be valued for who you are and not for what you do. Can produce feeling of being worthy.

Tell me they love me every day

Praise me when I do something good and reassure me they still love me when I fail

Ask about my day

Do special things for me out of the blue

Ask me questions about my day and life

Compliment me on my goals and just being me

#### AFFECTION

Physical means by which you can show love, care, and concern. Can generate feeling of being loved.

Talk to me, spend time together

Cuddle with me and tell me they love me

Hugs before bed

Hugs, kisses, and talking

Positive words and taking care of me

Cooks me things I like

#### **ACHIEVEMENT**

Recognition for specific accomplishments that they have achieved, or positive actions that contribute to the life of the teen. Can produce feeling of competence.

Being a son or daughter my parents can trust – anytime, anywhere

Being Student of the Month

Being honest when I could have easily lied

Getting my homework done

#### KEY MESSAGES

- IDENTITY CRISIS Proving yourself when you don't have to
- ATTITUDE Feeling unwanted creates a lack of respect

Every child wants to know they have a place in the world and that they're valuable. Some girls and boys might go to extreme lengths to prove their worth to the world; others might conclude that they are worthless. The world will constantly measure young people by impossible standards of beauty, strength, money, and intelligence.

A father has a critical role in affirming the worth of a child. The voice of a father can powerfully declare to his son or daughter that they have a God-given purpose and worth. A father can remind his daughter that she offers far more to the world than just her body, and his love won't diminish for her based on her report card. A father can praise his son for hard work and diligence whether or not he is a top athlete or honor student. The encouragement of a father helps to prepare a young person for healthy future relationships that are based on unconditional love and commitment.

Children who do not know the love of their father may seek to be validated and affirmed by a world that doesn't care about them. The world will always demand more than can possibly be given and will discard them as soon as their "usefulness" wears off



Hopefully, after these sessions, you will have the confidence and tools to speak to your kids about sex, to know the dangers involved in premarital sex, to see the beauty in waiting until marriage to have sex, to understand your child's daily reality of pressures to give in to sex before marriage, and, most importantly, to nurture the relationship with your kids.

# SET UP

- 1. Review page 45 with your child and ask them which of the 3As is most important to them.
- 2. As a family, discuss over a meal what it means to be made in the Image of God. (Refer to pages 5 and 43 for guidance.) How can this apply to our relationships?



**MEDIA:** What do movies and TV shows say is necessary for a successful relationship?

**PEERS:** Why do your friends decide to "break-up"? Is that decision based on what they want for themselves or what is best for each other?

**CHILD:** Do you have friendships and relationships that take work to maintain?

**FAMILY:** Share with your child the work and sacrifice needed for healthy friendships and marriage.

**GOD:** How does Scripture describe relationships? (John 15:13; Eph 5:25-29) Is it more of an emotion or choice to do what is best for another?

# **ACTION STEPS**

- 1. Cultivate relationships with other parents in order to encourage and support each other in parenting.
- As a family, take the love languages quiz at 5lovelanguages.com. Exchange names between family members. In the next week, demonstrate love to a family member using their love language.
- 3. Pray daily for God's strength and wisdom to raise the children who have been entrusted to you.
