- 3. Your personal attention and time
- 4. Discipline

- 6. Plans
- 7. Patience
- 8. Spiritual direction

What to do

- Tune into your child's needs. Every day you wait to attend to their needs, just brings you one day closer to them shutting you out of the game plan. They can shut you down.
- Learn what your children know that you need to be aware of.
- Realize that your kids want to please you.
- Make sure your kid feels like they hold a special, respected place in your home.
- Know your children's *priorities*, what's most important to them. You have to play along with their priorities, and every kid in your family is going be different.
- Consider the pressures that your children are under.
- Figure out what your child's passionate about and encourage that as best you can.
- Words are important. Depending on the words you use, you're either training your children up or you're training them down.
