Adam, Eve & Us

We search to external circumstances to fulfill an internal struggle, and so “who we are”, has been substituted with “what we are.”

The Bible tells us that we’re all descended from the same two people—Adam and Eve. *They were to look after the earth and the environment, and everything in it.*

Adam and Eve could talk to God anytime they wanted, just as we talk to each other today. This is the identity that we were all meant to have because *we were all created to be spiritually alive and connected to God with a deep sense of security, significance and acceptance.*

THE PROBLEM:

When they ate the fruit from the Tree of Knowledge of Good & Evil, they committed what we call the first sin, because they disobeyed God. The result was a total catastrophe, not just for them, but for everybody that came after them, including us. Because of their sin, you were born physically alive, but spiritually dead, so you’re born disconnected from God. And in our striving, our stories become all about us. It’s our needs, our comfort, our feelings, our image. *We end up looking to fill our needs outside of God because we become consumers with this unfillable void.*

Your Takeaway

Adam and Eve were significant, secure and accepted before they sinned. Because of them, your true identity was stolen, but because of Jesus, you now have it back. You are the righteousness of God. *If you see yourself as you really are, an unconditionally loved holy saint, then you’re more likely to stand firm and make the right choices!* When we start to believe the truth that there’s absolutely nothing we can do to earn God’s love because we already have it, our life begins to echo who we really are.
